Your Complainant, RUBY LEE BAGGETT, respectfully represents unto your Honor and this Honorable Court as follows:

l.

That your Complainant is a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama and a minor 16 years of age, and the Respondent is over 18 years of age and a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

2,

That your Complainant and the Respondent married at Lucedale, Mississippi, on April 5, 1945, and lived together as husband and wife until December 1, 1946.

That on, to-wit, December 1, 1946, and various other days prior thereto the Respondent threatened and abused the Complainant and did actual violence to her person which necessarily endangered her life and health; that the conduct

of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe that he would carry out his threats and do further voilence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE the premises considered, the Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process make the said HERTIS DOYLE BAGGETT partyRespondent to this bill of complaint, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practices of this Honorable Court.

Your Complainant further prays that your Honor will, upon a hearing hereof, enter an order and degree, granting to her an absolute decree of divorce forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; your Complainant further prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duty bound she will ever pray.
