My name is Ella Mae Black. I am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama, and have been all of my life. I am fourteen years old and live with my father, Robert Mosely at Stapleton in Baldwin County, Alabama. My mother is dead.

The Respondent, Hobbarb Hazel Black is twenty years old and now at Camp No. 5, McDavid, Florida.

The Respondent and I married at Bay Minette, Alabama, on May 18, 1946, and we lived together in Baldwin County, Alabama, until October 26, 1946,

The Respondent on, to-wit, October 26, 1946, and various other occasions threatened and abused me and did actual violence to my person by striking me with a beer bottle, which necessarily endangered my life and health. The conduct of the Respondent was such that I absolutely could not live with him, it was such as to give me every reasonable apprehension to believe and I did actually believe that if I continued to live with him he would do further violence to my person which would necessarily endanger my life and health.

Robert Mosely, a witness for the Complainant being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

My name is Robert Mosely. I am living at Stapleton, in Baldwin County, Alabama. I am the father of Ella Mae Black, who is now fourteen years old. Her mother is dead. I know that the conditions are such that my daughter and the Respondent, Hobbarb Hazel Black, cannot live together. He often, while they were living together abused my daughter. It was finally necessary that she leave him and come back home to live.



That on to-wit, October 26, 1946, and on other occasions prior thereto the Respondent cursed, threatened and abused and did actual violence to the Complainant which necessarily endangered her life and health; that the conduct of the Respondent was such as to give the Complainant every reasonable apprehension to believe and she did actually believe that if she continued to live with him he would carry out his threats and do actual violence to her person which would necessarily endanger her life and health.

WHEREFORE, The premises considered, Complainant prays that your Honor will by proper process, make the said Hobbard Hazel Black party Respondent to this cause of action, requiring him to plead, answer or demur to the same within the time and under the penalties prescribed by law and the practice of this Honorable Court.

Complainant further prays that your Honor will, upon a hearing hereof, enter an order and decree, granting to her an absolute decree of divorce, forever barring the bonds of matrimony existing between her and the Respondent; Complainant prays for such other, further, different or general relief as she may be in equity and good conscience entitled to receive, and as in duly bound she will ever pray.

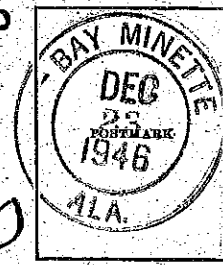

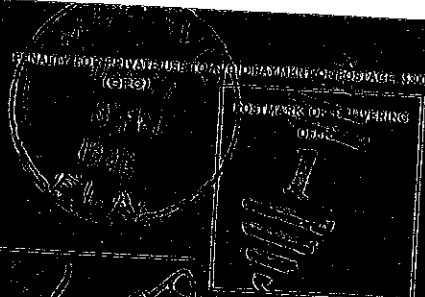
