Now come the plaintiffs and show to the Court that on the 18th day of September, 1936, a judgment was rendered in favor of the plaintiffs against the defendant for the sum of One Hundred and Twenty-nine Dollars (\$129.00) and for the sum of Eleven Dollars and Twenty-five Cents (\$11.25), costs in said suit, as will appear by Certificate of Judgment hereto attached, which certificate was registered in the office of the Probate Judge of said County in Judgment Book No. 2 page 361; that on March 16, 1937, M. H. Wilkins, as Sheriff of Baldwin County, was directed by the plaintiffs to levy on "one undivided fifth interest in the West Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 28, Township 8 South, Range 4 East"; that acting under said execution M. H. Wilkins, as Sheriff, levied on said undivided fifth interest and after advertising the same, as required by law, he sold said undivided one-fifth interest in the above described lands to S. P. 
