That he is 19 years of age and resides with his parents in Chilton County, State of Alabama. That on the 6th day of May 1935, he was arrested by Robert R. Nahrgang at a farm some miles from Foley in Baldwin County, Alabama. That he had been working on said farm being employed by the owners thereof to-wit: William F. Pfeiffer, C. O. Pfeiffer and Robert R. Nahrgang. That said Robert R. Nahrgang, at the time of the arrest of this affiant, and at the time of the occurrences herein stated was a part owner of said farm with said other parties and was general manager in charge of the operation of said farm, with general authority to manage and conduct business of same. That early on the morning of May 6th, 1935 affiant being on said farm seeking employment thereon was arrested, as stated, by Robert R. Nahrgang and was compelled to march more than a mile at the point of a rifle held by said Robert R. Nahrgang, to Foley, Baldwin County, Alabama. 




