Butler That he is 29 years of age and resides with his parents in Butler County, State of Alabama. That on the 6th day of May, 1935, he was arrested by Robert R. Wahrgang at a farm some miles from Foley in Baldwin County, Alabama. That he had been working on said farm being employed by the owners thereof to-wit: William F. Pfeiffer, C. O. Pfeiffer and Robert R. Wahrgang. That said Robert R. Wahrgang at the time of the arrest of this affiant, and at the time of the occurrences herein stated was a part owner of said farm with said other parties and was general manager in charge of the operation of said farm, with general authority to manage and conduct business of same. That early on the morning of May 6th, 1935, affiant being on said farm seeking employment thereon was arrested, as stated, by Robert R. Wahrgang and was compelled to march more than a mile at the point of a rifle held by said Robert R. Wahrgang, to Foley, Baldwin County, Alabama. 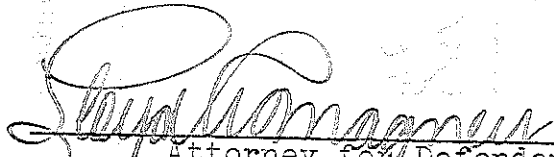
