The condition of the above obligation is such that Whereas the above bound Canterbury Motor Company, a corporation, has this day commenced its suit in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, against C. A. Henry and Marguerita Henry for the recovery of One 1932 V-8 Ford Coupe, and having made affidavit that the property sued for belongs to Canterbury Motor Company and entered into this bond, has obtained an order requiring the Sheriff of Baldwin County to take the property sued for into his possession;
