(\$3,581.00) Dollars, as damages for this, that hereto-
fore on, to-wit, the 26th day of July, 1937, James C.
Soward, the agent or servant of the defendant Muldon
Motor Company, while acting inline with and within the
Scope of his authority or employment as such agent or
servant, so negligently drove or operated an automobile
or truck on the public highway in Baldwin County, Ala-
bama in or near the town of Elberta, Alabama that as the
proximate result and consequence of such negligence said
automobile or truck ran into, over or against plaintiff's
intestate, and as the proximate result and consequence
thereof, plaintiff's intestate received injuries which
were the sole and proximate cause of her death, wherefore
plaintiff sues and asks judgement in the aforementioned
sum of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty One and No/100ths
(\$3,581.00) Dollars.

2. Plaintiff claims of the defendants the fur-
ther sum of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty One and
No/100ths (\$3,581.00) Dollars as damages for this, that
heretofore on, to-wit, the 26th day of July, 1937, de-
fendant Muldon Motor Company, acting by and through its

agent or servant, defendant James C. Soward, while such agent or servant was acting within the line and scope of his authority or employment as such agent or servant of defendant Muldon Motor Company, wantonly killed plaintiff's intestate by wantonly driving or operating an automobile or truck on or near the public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama in or near the town of El-Berta, Alabama in such a manner that as the proximate result of said wantonness, said automobile or truck ran into, over or against plaintiff's intestate, thereby proximate causing her death, wherefore plaintiff sues and asks judgement in the aforementioned sum of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Eighty One and No/100ths (\$3,581.00) Dollars.
