Count one. The plaintiff claims of the defendant the following personal property, viz.:

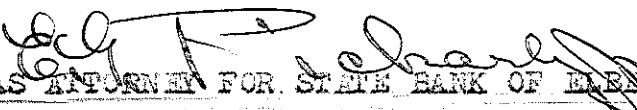
One two horse farmwagon (Jno Deer)

One 12" Oliver Breaking plow.
One 10 cutter disc harrow.
One Seven year old gray mare. (Named Maud.)

together with twenty-five (\$25.00) damages for the unlawful detention thereof.

Count two. The plaintiff further claims of the defendant the sum of ~~ONE HUNDRED THIRTY-TWO AND FIFTY ONE~~ HUNDREDS DOLLARS (\$132.50) due by a promissory note made by the defendant on the twentieth day of February, 1937 and payable on to-wit the twentieth day of June, 1937 together with interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum since the fifth day of July, 1937, which sum of money together with the interest thereon is still due and unpaid.

Count three. The plaintiff further claims of the defendant the sum of Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) as an attorney's fee provided for in said note in the event that collection became necessary.
