KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, BOATYARD TIMBER COMPANY, a corporation, and W. D. Owens, W. H. Wilkins James L. Owens & J. H. Owens are held and firmly bound unto LILLIE SMITH in the sum of Six Hundred & no/100 DOLLARS, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this the 15th day of January, 1936.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, an execution issued from the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, bearing date of issuance the 21 day of December, 1935, in favor of Lillie Smith and against W. D. Owens for the sum of Three Hundred & no/100 DOLLARS, ^{interest and costs} has been levied by M. H. Wilkins, Sheriff of said County, upon the following, as the property of W. D. Owens, to-wit:

All paper wood or pulp wood that has been cut and all timber suitable for pulp wood that will measure 6 inches in diameter 14 feet above the ground that is now located on the following described property in Baldwin County, Alabama, to-wit:
