COUNT 1: The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), as damages, for that, whereas, on, to-wit, February 27th, 1936, while Plaintiff's truck was being driven along that certain public highway leading from Loxley, Alabama, to Mobile, Alabama, and at a point in Baldwin County, Alabama, about one mile from the Mobile County line, and about four miles from the eastern terminus of the Cochrane Bridge, which said truck was loaded with hogs, Defendant negligently ran an automobile against said truck, and as a result thereof said truck was badly damaged, the tail gate being broken, the windshield broken, fenders badly dented, and other injuries to said truck, all to the great damage of the Plaintiff as aforementioned.

COUNT 2: Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the further sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), as damages, for that, whereas, on, to-wit, February 27th, 1936, while Plaintiff's truck was being driven along that certain public highway leading from Loxley, Alabama, to Mobile, Alabama, and at a point in Baldwin County, Alabama, about one mile from the Mobile County line, and about four miles from the eastern terminus of the Cochrane Bridge, which said truck was loaded with hogs, Defendant negligently ran an automobile against said truck, and as a result thereof three of Plaintiff's hogs were caused to escape from said truck, and Plaintiff has been unable to find two of said hogs, all to the great damage of the Plaintiff in the sum aforementioned.
