TESTIMONY OF LORENZO ANDERSON.

My name is Lorenzo Anderson and I am the Complainant in this case for divorce against Amy Anderson. I am over twenty-one years of age and am a bona fide resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. I have resided continuously, and have been such bona fide resident for more than twelve months next preceding the filing of this bill of Complaint. The said Amy Anderson is over the age of twenty-one years and is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama. I and the said Amy Anderson were lawfully married in Bay Minette, Baldwin County, Alabama on October 1st, 1927 at the Court House by the Probate Judge. My name is Palmos Anderson, and I live at Stockton, Baldwin County, Alabama. I am fifty-four years of age and am the father of Lorenzo Anderson. I remember the occasion when Amy Anderson left my son, Lorenzo Anderson, without any fault on his part, as he has always been a hard-working boy and took good care of her when they were living together. She voluntarily abandoned him about March 9, 1934, more than three years next preceding the filing of the Bill of Complaint in this cause. He has lived in Stockton, Baldwin County, Alabama and has been a bona fide resident thereof all of his life. After his wife, Amy Anderson, went off and left him, he came to my house and has lived with me ever since. I see him nearly every day and know that he has not lived with her since the separation, as man and wife or otherwise.
