And now comes the Defendant and moves the Court to transfer this cause from the Law to the Equity side of the Court, for the reason that an equitable question, the decision of which should dispose of the cause, which cannot be disposed of in the Law side of the Court, depends upon the assertion of an equitable question or right of defense by the Defendant, the substance of which is as follows:

That sometime during to-wit, the year 1929, the Plaintiff entered into a contract with the Defendant to sell and convey to him, upon the performance of certain conditions, a tract of land in Baldwin County, Alabama, described as follows, to-wit:

The Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter
of Section 12, Township 7 South of Range 3 East,

which includes the property described in the original complaint in this cause;

That the Defendant was in the possession of the property at the time the contract was entered into and upon entering into the contract he paid a part of the purchase price and the Plaintiff allowed him to remain in possession; that the Defendant, with full knowledge of the Plaintiff, has cleared and fenced a part of the land and built improvements thereon;

That the Defendant called upon the Plaintiff for a statement of the balance due upon the said contract and upon being advised of this amount, secured the funds, tendered it to the Plaintiff and demanded a deed; that the Plaintiff refused and has con-

tinued to refuse to comply with the contract and execute deed to the Defendant;

That though the Defendant has complied in part and offered to comply in toto with the contract and has repeatedly demanded a deed from the Plaintiff in compliance with the contract, the Plaintiff refused to give him such deed.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant moves that this cause may be transferred to the Equityside of the docket in order that the equitable defense and rights above set forth may be availed of by the Defendant, and that the Court may take jurisdiction of the cause for the full and final determination of the rights and liabilities of the parties affected thereby.
