SURETY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 3rd day of November, 1936 between ORVIS M. BROWN, attorney for C. M. Jarman, of the first part and J. L. TUCKER, party of the second part, agree as follows, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the said party of the second part having leased certain drum and cable, part of the skidder attachmen t from one A. C. Diamond of Pensacola, Florida and WHEREBY said drum and cable having been attached while in the possession and use of one Plese Glass as the property of said Plese Glass and WHEREAS the party of the second part assumes liability in case that party of the first part shall recover a judgment against the said Plese Glass upon the condition that should the records of Florida fail to show that the title to this certain drum and cable is vested in A. C. Diamond then he reassumes liability to the amount of the retail value of the drum and cable and this drum and cable are released upon this condition.

In consideration of the execution of this agreement I as the attorney for said C. M. Jarman hereby release this cable and drum as the property of A. C. Diamond and hereby authorize Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama to so release this property upon these terms and conditions and hereby discharge the Sheriff from any liability by reason of this discharge should it prove not to be the property of the said A. C. Diamond.
