
To the Honorable Francis W Hare, Judge of the Twenty First

Humbly complaining, Your Oratrix, Cora Gentry, Alias Cora
Fletcher,, respectfully represents to your Honor as follows:
1. Your Oratrix, said Cora Gentry, alias Cora Fletcher, and
Paschal Gentry were married in Baldwin County, Alabama, on,
towit,, June 5th, 1934 at Bay Minette, Alabama and lived as
husband and wife in Baldwin County, Alabama, until, towit,
January 3rd, 1935, when they separated while living at Mrs
Hand' place on Railroad Street in said town of Bay Minette,
on that ~~day~~ day said respondent left and abandoned me without
just cause of legal excuse; he drove me ~~me~~ off from the house
we were living in at the time and forbade me to return and
since said time, towit, January 3rd 1935, we have not lived
together as husband and wife; at the time said respondent
threatened to kill me , if I did not leave.; he struck me
with his fist on said Jan. 3rd, 1935 and I had been sick in
bed for about two weeks; he knocked me down, cursed me and
forced me to leave; prior to that I had helped him saw logs

I did all I knew how to make him a dutiful and faithful wife;
Said abandonment of ^{me} by said Paschal Gentry occurred for
