HALL and BESSIE HALL in the sum of ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00), for which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this the 2nd day of November, 1936.

The condition of ~~this~~ obligation is such, that Whereas, the above named C. M. Coghlan commenced an action of detinue against the said R. H. Hall and Bessie Hall by issuing Writ of Detinue from the Circuit Court of said County on the 27th day of October, 1936, by which, together with endorsements thereon, any Sheriff of the State of Alabama was commanded to take into his possession the following described property, to-wit:

which said writ was on the 29th day of October, 1936, placed in the hands of M. H. Wilkins, Sheriff of said County, for due execution thereof, and which said writ said M. H.
