

Suit on Promissory Waive Note

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Eight and 05/100 Dollars (\$108.05) due by Promissory Waive Note made by him on the 15th day of November, 1930, and payable the 22nd day of November, 1930, which said Promissory Note is of the face value of One Hundred Twenty Three Dollars and Five cents (\$123.05), but of which the Plaintiff claims the sum of One Hundred Eight and 05/100 Dollars (\$108.05) as due; and the Plaintiff alleges that a payment was made on said note by the said Defendant on the 6th day of December, 1930; the Plaintiff also claims of the Defendant as part of said indebtedness interest at the rate of 8% from the 15th day of November, 1930, together with the further and additional sum of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) as a reasonable attorney's fee as provided in said Note, and together with the costs of this suit. The Plaintiff alleges that as a part of the said Note, the Defendant has waived all
