The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars, due by promissory note made by the Defendants, on the 11th day of October, 1938, and payable Twenty-five and 20/100 (\$25.20) Dollars per month, on or before the 11th day of each month, beginning November 11th, 1938, together with interest thereon at 8% per annum from date.

The Plaintiff alleges that said note was given to evidence the indebtedness due by the Defendants to the Plaintiff by mortgage dated October 10th, 1938, which said mortgage provided that failure to pay any one or part of any one of the notes secured when same matured, should cause all the notes and debt secured to become immediately due and payable; that the Defendants have defaulted in payments on said note and the Plaintiff has elected to declare the entire indebtedness due.

The Plaintiff admits payments on said note totaling Seven Hundred Seventy-six and 23/100 (\$776.23) Dollars.

The Plaintiff further alleges that the Defendants, in, by and as a part

of said note waived demand and protest and notice of demand, non-payment and protest, and agreed to pay all costs of collecting or securing, or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee.

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars as a reasonable attorney's fee.
