## PLEA IN ABATEMENT

Comes now the Defendant, C. C. REUTERMAN, by his attorney, Leslie Hall, and enters hereby his SPECIAL APPEARANCE in this cause, and prays the judgment of the Court that the Writ of Attachment and Levy thereof be quashed because he says that:

1. The Return of the sheriff endorsed on said Writ is not true, but that the same is erroneous and false in the following particulars, to-wit:

The return of the sheriff on said Writ is set forth in words and figures as follows:

"I have, this the 3rd day of March, 1939, executed the within Writ of Attachment by attaching one (1) Chrysler Coupe, Motor Number C7-18590, the property of C. C. Reuterman, the Defendant. W. R. Stuart, Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama. By John R. Davis. D. S."

Whereas the Defendant alleges that the said sheriff did not levy on the automobile described in said Return, but the Defendant alleges that the said sheriff did levy on a automobile described as follows, to-wit:

2.
