
doth depose and say as follows:

My name is Paschal Gentry. I live at Bay Minette, Alabama and I have lived in Baldwin County for thirty-five years, I am a bona fide resident citizen of Baldwin County, and have been so for more than three years before the filing of the Complaint in this cause. Cora Gentry, alias Cora Fletcher, and myself were legally married in Baldwin County on June 5th, 1934, at Bay Minette, Alabama; and we lived together as husband and wife until, to-wit: Jan. 3rd, 1935. At which time the respondent, my wife, Cora Gentry, voluntarily abandoned me, without any just cause or excuse therefor. And since the said abandonment she has stayed and refused to resume marital relationships with me; and since said abandonment on, to-wit, Jan 3rd, 1935; we have not lived together as husband and wife. This abandonment by me by Cora Gentry took place while we lived together at Mrs. Hand's place in Bay Minette, Ala. Since that time I have continued to live at Bay Minette; My wife, Cora Gentry, alias Cora Fletcher, has lived at different places since the abandonment; At Bay Minette; some time in South Baldwin, some time in Escambia County, Ala. She is at present in Atmore, in Escambia County where she lives temporarily; and which is her present post office address. Both my wife, Cora Gentry and myself are over twenty-one years of age;.



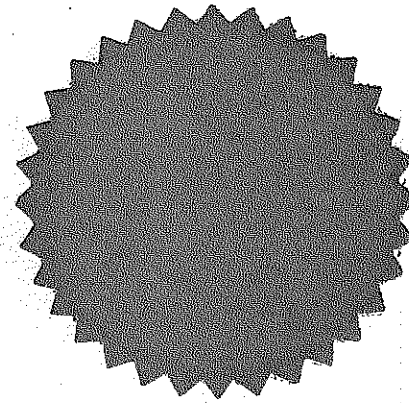
It is further ordered that PASCHAL GENTRY and CORA GENTRY be, and they are hereby permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of this suit.
