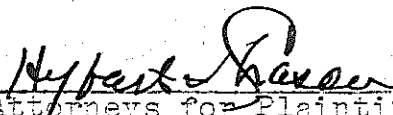

said note the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting or securing or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable Attorney's fee, whether the same be collected or secured by suit or otherwise, and the Plaintiff further claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) as such reasonable Attorney's fee.

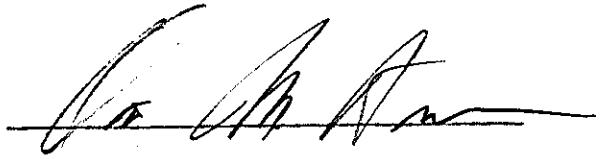

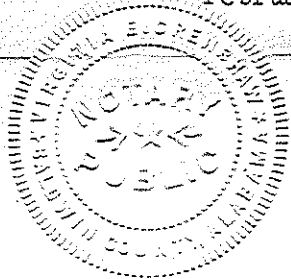

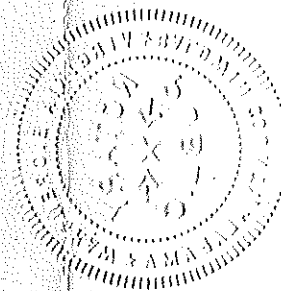
