FIRST:

That a suit by the above Plaintiff and against the above Defendant, and involving the same and identical subject matter, was filed in the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, at law, on September 16th, 1939, and service on the Defendant perfected on September 21st, 1939.

SECOND:

That the Defendant filed demurrers to the Plaintiff's complaint, which were on August 21st, 1940, overruled, and on the following day, August 22nd, 1940, the Defendant filed his answer.

THIRD:

That on September 11th, 1940, at a regular term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, the said case was called and the Plaintiff and Defendant both announced ready; that after the impanelling of the jury, the statement of the case and the entrance into the trial of the same, the Plaintiff took a non-suit with bill of exceptions, and at the request of the Plaintiff's attorney, the following order was entered by the Court: "Plaintiff takes a non-suit with bill of exceptions because of the adverse ruling of the Court on the evidence."

FOURTH:

That on September 11th, 1940, the Plaintiff filed a motion for a re-instatement of said cause and a new trial; that said motion, although more than thirty days have expired, has never been presented to the Court and ruling secured thereon, nor has said motion been marked "continued" from time to time, as required by law.

FIFTH:

That on September 21st, 1940, the Defendant filed an answer to the Plaintiff's motion for a new trial and re-instatement of said cause.

SIXTH:

That said original cause upon the docket of the Circuit Court of Baldwin

County, Alabama, at Law, is No. 539.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant prays that the present suit be forthwith dismissed.

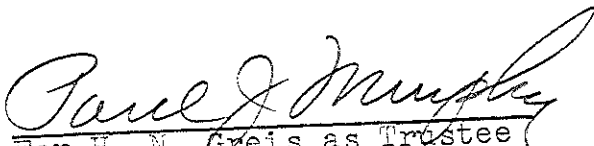

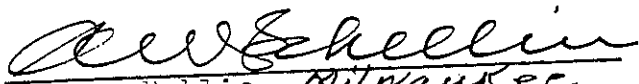

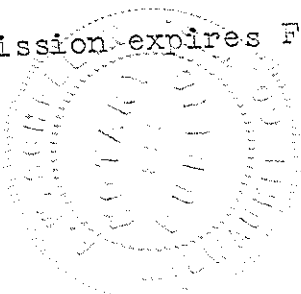
