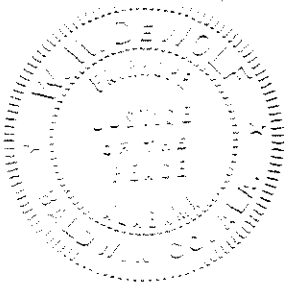

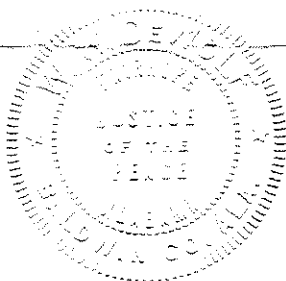

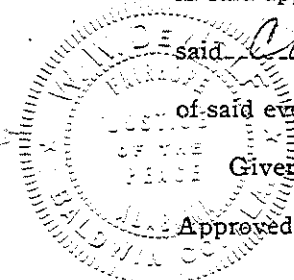

Dear Sir:

On December 31, 1940, about 11 o'clock, Miss Emma Bloomquist came into my office with a laceration on the outer external surface of the right leg about the middle third, which she stated was caused by the bite of a dog. The wound was cleaned with iodine and alcohol and dressed, and 1500 units of anti-tetanus serum was given.

Miss Bloomquist has had for several months an incision where the right kidney was removed. This incision has been draining and I feel that this drainage was increased from the above accident. Moreover, she ran an elevated temperature for several days, which was not present at the time of this accident. In addition, there was a pronounced hematuria which was not evident a few days before this wound was inflicted. It was necessary to see Miss Bloomquist and dress this wound five times. Unfortunately she developed an urticarial rash following the injection of anti-tetanus serum which made her quite uncomfortable for some little time, and which necessitated treatment.
