THAT WHEREAS, on 8th day of June, A. D. 1931, the Probate Court of Baldwin County rendered a decree for the sale of lands hereinafter described and conveyed, for the payment of State and County taxes then due from J. Fink the owner of said lands and for the payment of the fees, costs, and expenses of and under said decree, and the sale had in execution thereof.

Schoen bought this land from the State of Alabama on the 3rd day of September, 1936 and in this purchase paid the taxes for 1931,1932,1933,1934,1935 and 1936 and that Joe F. Schoen received the title to this above described property by this State Tax Deed dated September 3rd, 1936 and the said Ignatz Fink and Marie Fink received this property by warranty deed dated January 2, 1922 from the Baldwin County Colonization Company, Inc., a Corporation, who are named as the Respondents in this action to quiet title, and that the said Ignatz Fink and Marie Fink, his wife, have been in possession of the said lands up to the time the same were taken possession by the complainant, Joe F. Schoen, claiming to own the same in fee simple for more than ten years

prior to the filing of the bill of complaint in this suit. And that on April 22nd, 1930 Ignatz Fink and Marie Fink, husband and wife, conveyed by Marranty Deed to the Baldwin County Colonization Company the lands described above in fee simple. And that the said Complainant, Joe F. Schoen, and those under whom he claims have paid the taxes which have been due for more than ten years prior to the filing of the bill of complaint in this suit, that no other person, firm or corporation has paid any taxes on the same during that period of time; that there are no suits pending to contest Complainant's title to, interest in, or right of possession of the said lands; that the said property stands in the name of Joe F. Schoen on the Records of Baldwin County, Alabama and that he has paid the taxes on the same and those under whom he claims since the year 1926;

It is, therefore, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant, Joe F. Schoen, is the absolute owner of the following described property, to-wit: "The Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty two, Township Seven South of Range Five East in Baldwin County, Alabama, containing Forty acres more or less" in fee simple, in his own right, and that no other person, firm or corporation has any interest, right, title, lien or encumbrance on said lands held by anyone other than the Complainant and that same are hereby and herein declared null and void, and are decreed to be a cloud upon the title of Complainant and moved as such. That a certified copy of this decree be filed in the Probate Office of the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, and recorded therein, and that it be indexed on the records in the direct indexes in the office of the Judge of the said Court in the name of J. Fink, Ignatz Fink and Marie Fink, Henry C. Bartling, individually, and Henry C. Bartling as trustee of said lands, and the Baldwin County Colonization Company, Inc., a corporation, and in the indirect indexes in the name of Joe F. Schoen.

And it is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Complainant pay the costs of this proceeding.
