Your petitioner, Steven Stejskal, by his attorney

24th day of March 1941, judgment was rendered against him
in favor of one Guernsey Clarke and Sanford Clarke doing
business as Clarke Brothers, by G. H. Perkins, a Notary
Public with the powers of a Justice of said county for
the sum of One Hundred Eighty two Dollars \$182.00 damages
and court costs not disclosed to petitioner in a suit
wherein the said Guernsey Clarke and Sanford Clarke
doing business as Clarke Brothers were plaintiff and your
petitioner the defendant.

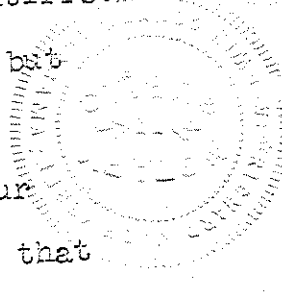
And your petitioner avers that said judgment was
unwarranted by the law and the facts in this:

1. Your petitioner was served with an execution upon
a purported judgment on the 18th of March 1941 never having
previously been served with a summons. And said execution
had no dates thereon.

2. The following days your petitioner endeavored to
learn whether there had been a trial and if not when one
would be held. Petitioner avers that he was unable to secure
adequate information about the matter from Notary Public
Perkins but was finally told that the trial would be held
Monday March 24, 1941 but Notary Public Perkins refused to
disclose the time of said trial.

3. On Saturday March 22, 1941 at about 8:15 A. M.
your petitioner filed a verified statement with Notary
Public Perkins setting forth an issue of fact on what
he presumed to be the Complaint of the aforesaid Plaintiffs.
Petitioner again tried to learn the time of the trial but
this information was not disclosed to him.

4. On Monday March 25th 1941 at about 1 P. M. your
petitioner went to Notary Public Perkins and was told that
the trial had been held and that petitioner was guilty.



Petitioner then ask to see the charges and the complaint that had been filed against him and was told that he could not see them. Petitioner then ask to see the record of the trial and was told that he could not see that either. Petitioner then ask to see the judgment against him and he was told that he could not see this either. Petitioner then ask for an appeal bond and was told that the amount of the appeal bond would be Three Hundred and sixty-four Dollars (\$364.60) which amount was twice the amount of the judgment. He was given an appeal bond form only.

Wherefore petitioner prays that your honor will order writs of certiorari to issue in said cause to the said Notary Public with powers of Justice, G. H. Perkins returnable to the Circuit Court of Baldwin County Alabama as required by law, in order that justice may be done in the premises.
