## ORDER

In the Circuit Court of Baldwin County Alabama At Lew

Before me Frank Vorel, a Notary Public in and for said county and state, personally appeared Steve Stejskal who being known to me and who first being sworn to tell the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth does depose and say, that March I8th, I94I at hours between 9:50 to I0:30 a. m. he had handed Ten Dollars in United States Currency to Guernsey Clarke in his office, 205 East Side Section Street, at Fairhope, Alabama and as he handed this money, he states to Guernsey Clarke, quote, "here is the rent money, Mer the coming month" and again repeated, quote, "that is the money for the rent".

Mr. Steve Stejskal states that Guernsey Clarke held money on his palm and place his thumb over the money taking it to his possession, Deparent then reached into his left rear packet and taken out a notice, which he had executed 17th day of Mærch, I94I, and handed this notice at same time to him, quote, "here is your notice that in 60 days I will be moving out". Mr. Guernsey Clarke took this notice into the left hand over the money he was holding.

That Guernsey Clarke excepted physically possession of this notice. Deponent further states that he walked out of Guernsey Clarke office into the next room adjoining his place. Whereupon Guernsey Clarke called to the deponent and told him that he refuses to take it, and see his attorney. To which the Deponent replied, "you have taken it, and you go and see my attorney" after which the deponent went to his room and shut the door.

Deponent states that during the present of this interviewwwith Guensey Clarke, the deponent and Frank Vorel were present.

Deponent states that the reason for him to be a holdover tenant is that the building which is being prected will be completed in few weeks and asks the honorable court to grant the deponent to stay on the present premises which will not exceed the time stated in the 60 day notice which deponent personally handed over to Guernsey Clarke as stated above.


