Probably you have already been served notice, but I thought best to advise you that this man has become a Bankrupt at Mobile, and the Bankrupt Court has ordered that I pay into that Court here all earnings pricer to February 10th, 1942

I judge above indebtedness has been scheduled; at any rate, I will not have anything to answer on the garnishment, because of the Bankrupt Order.
