The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant One Hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$165.00) due by Three Promissory Notes made by her on, to-wit, January 14, 1941 and payable on, to-wit, Fifteen Days after date; on, to-wit, April 21, 1941 and payable on, to-wit, Thirty Days after date; on, to-wit, May 14, 1941 and payable on to-wit, Thirty Days after date with interest at the rate of Eight per cent (8%) per annum from August 1, 1941.

The Plaintiff avers that in and by the terms of said Notes the Defendant waived as to this debt all right of exemption under the Constitution and laws of Alabama or any other State, and of this waiver the Plaintiff now claims the benefit.
