

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Four Hundred Forty-six Dollars (\$446.00) due by a promissory waive note, made by the Defendant on the 15th day of February, 1940 and payable to Mobile Fertilizer Company one hundred five (105) days after date, which said note is the property of the Plaintiff and is still due and unpaid, together with interest thereon from its due date. Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of the said note the Defendant waived all rights of exemption as to this debt and also agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee for the collection of same, which attorney's fee the Plaintiff alleges to be Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00) and which he herewith claims.

2. The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of One Hundred Forty-five and 30/100 Dollars (\$145.30) due by a promissory waive note, made by the Defendant on the 5th day of April, 1940, and payable to the Plaintiff sixty (60) days after said date, the said note is the property of the Plaintiff, is still due and unpaid, together with interest thereon from its due date. Plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of the said note the Defendant waived all rights of exemption as to this debt and also agreed to pay a reasonable attorney's fee for the collection of same, which attorney's fee the Plaintiff alleges to be Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and which he herewith claims.


