TO ANY LAWFUL OFFICER OF THE COUNTY OF BALDWIN:

You are hereby commanded to attach the specific personal property and deliver the same to Evelyn Payne which she recovered of Ronald A. Gunnison on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, day of November, in the Justice Court of G. E. Perkins of said county and which was therein adjudged to be delivered to said Evelyn Payne, to-wit: One tan cow, if the same may be had; Or if the said Ronald A. Gunnison secrete or remove the said property so that it cannot be attached by you and delivered to said Evelyn Payne, then you are commanded to distrain Ronald A. Gunnison by all his real and personal estate in your county, so that thereon he do not lay hands, until he deliver to you or to Evelyn Payne the specific property mentioned above, recoverable of him by Evelyn Payne, if the same may be had; but if not, then you shall causet to be made of such estate of Ronald A. Gunnison the alternative price and value of said specific property, to-wit: ninety-five dollars, together with damages for the detention and costs; and if the property be delivered you will then cause to be made only the damages for detention and costs, and make due return of this writ to this court how you have executed the same.

We, Ronald A. Gunnison, as principal, and Herbert Gabel,  
and George Gabel as sureties, are bound unto  
Evelyn Payne in the sum of One Hundred and Ninety Dollars, for the  
payment of which we, jointly and severally, bind ourselves, our heirs,  
executors and administrators.

The condition of above obligation is such that on the 21st day  
of November, G. E. Perkins, a Justice of the Peace in and for said  
County, rendered a judgment in favor of the said Evelyn Payne against  
Ronald A. Gunnison for the delivery of one      tan                      cow or  
its alternate value of Ninety-five Dollars debt and together with  
costs of suit from which judgment the said Ronald Gunnison has  
applied for and obtained an appeal to the next term of the Circuit  
Court of Baldwin County. Now if said Ronald A. Gunnison shall  
prosecute said appeal to effect, or, if he fail in said appeal, shall  
return the personal property sued for or its alternate value to-  
gether with such judgment as may be rendered against him by the  
said Circuit Court, then in either of said events, this obligation  
to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
