The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant ONE THOUSAND (\$1000.00) DOLLARS, for that heretofore on towit, Decemberl, 1945, the Plaintiff was operating his automobile truck along the "Jack Springs" road, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, at a point approximately seven miles from Bay Minette; that the Defendant at said time and place negligently drove an automobile truck into or against the automobile truck of the Plaintiff and as a proximate result of said negligence the automobile truck of the Plaintiff was damaged as follows; the differential was broken; the springs were broken; the transmission was broken; the chasis and wheels were damaged; two tires were damaged; the truck was otherwise damaged; that the said truck was used to haul paper wood; that the Plaintiff lost the use of the truck for five days; all to the damage of the Plaintiff as aforesaid.

COUNTER CLAIM

THIRD:

The Defendant, A. B. McDill, pleads specially by way of recoupment and claims of the Plaintiff the sum of ONE THOUSAND (\$1000.00) DOLLARS, as damages, for that, at the time and place complained of in the Complaint, the Defendant, A. B. McDill, was then and there driving an automobile truck along the "Jack Springs" road, a public highway in Baldwin County, Alabama, at a point approximately seven miles from Bay Minette, Alabama, where he had a right to be, at which time and place the Plaintiff negligently drove an automobile truck into or against the automobile truck belonging to the Defendant and which he was then and there driving, thereby damaging the front and left side of said automobile truck as follows: the left front fender and left running board were damaged; the drive shaft was rulned; the left rear tire was rulned; the left rear springs were broken; the left front wheel was damaged; that the said truck was used to haul lime; that the Defendant lost the use of the truck for five days; all to the damage of the Defendant in the sum above claimed and he briggs this counter-claim against the Plaintiff and asks judgment for the above amount; the Defendant further avers that the negligence of the Plaintiff in and about the operation of his automobile truck as aforesaid was the proximate cause of the damages to the automobile truck of the Defendant.
