Raymond Crosby, as Executor aforesaid, is necessary to obtain satisfaction of said judgment.

You are, therefore, hereby commanded to summon J. Raymond Crosby, as Executor of the Estate of Louisa Dean, to be and appear before the Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama at the court house thereof within thirty days from the service of this writ, then and there to answer on oath, whether he was indebted to the above named Defendant at the time of the service of this summons, or at the time of making his answer thereto and in what sum or sums and whether he will not be indebted in future to said Defendant by a contract then existing or at the time of the service of this summons; and whether he has not in his possession or under his control personal or real property or things in action belonging to the said Defendant, Tom Dean.

Herein fail not, and have you then and there this writ.
