The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED (\$700.00) DOLLARS for in this, that on to-wit: the 1st day of September, 1942, the Defendant or others by his authority and direction did enter upon the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 4 North, Range 3 East, and did willfully and knowingly cut therefrom seventy (70) pine trees without the consent of the owner of said lands, and Plaintiff avers at the time of the cutting of the said timber Plaintiff was the owner of said land and said timber.

COUNT TWO:
