TO THE HONORABLE R. S. DUCK, REGISTER OF THE CIRCUIT COURT OF
BALDWIN COUNTY, ALABAMA:

The undersigned, A. B. Corley, Jr., respectfully represents
as follows:

1. That he is the Defendant in the above entitled cause
and that he desires that the testimony of Grady L. Walton and Guy
W. Lindsey be taken conditionally and perpetuated in the manner pro-
vided by Title 7, Sections 491-97 of the 1940 Code of Alabama.

2. The testimony of the witness, Grady L. Walton, who is
a member of the armed forces of the United States and who is at
present stationed at Camp Gordon Johnston, Carrabelle, Florida, is
necessary to the defense of such suit; that the facts generally
expected to be proved by the said witness are substantially as fol-
lows: That he was a member of the armed forces of the United States
during the month of May, 1943; that he came to Bay Minette, Alabama
on leave on to-wit, May 24, 1943 and remained until on to-wit, May
27, 1943; that while he was in Bay Minette, Alabama on such leave,
he, together with the prosecuting witness in this case, namely,
Judy Brown, went to Atmore, Alabama, drank intoxicating liquors
together, remained together from late in one afternoon until during
the morning of the next day; that they parked their automobile near
Dyas Creek, in Baldwin County, Alabama and while they were together
at the said time and place had sexual intercourse on several occasions.

3. The testimony of the witness Guy W. Lindsey, who is now
temporarily residing in Baldwin County, Alabama, but who expects to
leave here permanently and accept employment in the State of
Mississippi before November 1st, 1943, is necessary to the defense of
this suit. The facts generally expected to be proved by the said
witness are substantially as follows: That he left Bay Minette,
Alabama to become a member of the armed forces of the United States
on Tuesday, May 11, 1943; that on the afternoon of Monday, May 10, 1943,

he got the prosecuting witness in this case, namely, Judy Brown, carried her to Flomaton, Alabama where the two of them rented a tourist camp or cabin and where they remained together until the early morning hours of May 11th; that while they were together between the afternoon of May 10th and the time they returned to Bay Minette on the morning of May 11th, they drank liquor or intoxicating beverages together and that he had sexual intercourse with the said prosecuting witness on several occasions during the said period of time.

WHEREFORE the undersigned Defendant prays that an order be made in the manner provided by Title 7, Section 493 of the 1940 Code of Alabama allowing the examination of the said witnesses in the manner provided therein and that notice of such examination be given to the said prosecuting witness, Judy Brown, who is a resident of Baldwin County, Alabama.

Defendant further prays that such other orders be made and decrees rendered as may be requisite and proper in the premises.
