Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of Two Hundred Seventeen Dollars and Forty-four Cents (\$217.44), due from him by promissory note made to L. J. Hooper, doing business as Hooper Brothers, dated March 12, 1944, due June 12, 1944, with interest thereon.
