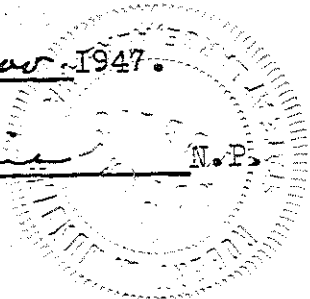

in the sum of Three Thousand Dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we jointly and severally bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the said Glen Hall and L.G.

Boykin did, on the 1st day of November 1947 sue out of the Circuit Court of Baldwin County Alabama a writ of detinue directed to any Sheriff of the State of Alabama commanding him

to take into his possession the following property, to-wit:

One Shrimp trawler with cabin aft, about 34 feet long and about 8½ feet wide, by the name of Jewel C and numbered I9A34

which said writ was placed in the hands of Taylor Wilkins

Sheriff of Baldwin County, Alabama, on the 1st day of November, 19 47, and executed by him on the 1st day of November, 19 47, by taking into his possession the following property, to-wit:

One shrimp trawler with cabin aft, about 34 feet long and about 8½ feet wide, by the name of Jewel C and numbered I9A34

And whereas the said A.D. Magnuson Defendant in said writ, has failed and neglected for the space of five days from the execution of said writ to give bond and take possession of said property as authorized by law.

Boykin upon his failing in said suit shall deliver the said property to the Defendant within thirty days after judgment and pay all damages for the detention of the property and costs of suit, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
