In, by and as a part of said note the Defendant waives all rights of exemption under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Alabama or any other State in the United States, and agrees to pay for the advertising, selling, conveying and attorney's fees, which fee plaintiffs alleges to be \$500.00, and claims herewith.

AFFIDAVIT OF B. K. THIEM

B. K. Thiem, first being duly sworn, deposes and says as follows:

That he is the Plaintiff in the case of Mr. and Mrs. B. K. Thiem vs. Claude Peteet, that on January 21, 1947, Claude Peteet executed one prom_ issory note to Mr. and Mrs. B. K. Thiem in the principal amount of \$5,100.00, which was due and payable as follows: "Payable \$500.00 Feby. 1st, 1947, and \$250.00 and interest monthly after date hereof," that the payments made on said note are as follows: February 5, 1947, \$500.00, leaving a principal balance of \$4,600.00; March 5, 1947, \$250.00, leaving a principal balance of \$4,350.00; and on January 28, 1948, \$300.00, which was applied as follows: \$30.00 of which was paid to Attorney Forest A. Christian, as attorney's fees, (having delivered the note to him for collection on December 13, 1947) and the balance of \$270.00 was applied to the delinquent interest. Accordingly, there is a principal balance of \$4,350.00 due and a balance of interest of \$67.75. However, since this note does not provide for acceleration of payments in case of delinquency or default, we are at this time suing only for the amount due, which is \$3,000.00, plus the aforesaid interest of \$67.75. which pays the interest to March 21, 1948.
