## COMPLAINT

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of \$204.00 on breach of agreement entered into by him on the 25th day of October, 1947, wherein the defendant sold an automobile, described as: Used \_ Model 1935 \_ 8 Cylinder Buick \_ 4.D Sedan, Motor No. 2961796, to one, Isiah McCall under a Conditional Sale Contract, by which he promised, jointly and severally, with the said Isiah McCall to pay \$216.00, principal, payable in eighteen (18) weekly installments of \$12.00 each, together with interest at the highest lawful rate, after maturity.

The Sales Contract provides that "15% of the amount due hereunder shall be paid by the purchaser as attorney's fees."

The defendant in, by and part of said Conditional Sales Contract, waives all homestead and other property exemption laws.
