FIRST

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant the sum of ONE THOUSAND (\$1000.00) DOLLARS, damages for trespass by the Defendant on the following tract of land, viz: the Northeast quarter of Section 9, Township 6 South, Range 5 East, of Baldwin County, Alabama, belonging to John Ondracka, Plaintiff, and for cutting the timber thereon and injuring the lands by cutting ruts thereon and causing washes therein, on and during, to-wit, the months of April and May, 1944;

SECOND

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant ONE THOUSAND FORTY (\$1040.00) DOLLARS as damages for this, that, the Defendant during the months of April and May, 1944, willfully and knowingly, without the consent of John Ondracka, the owner of the land, cut down one hundred and four pine trees on the Northeast quarter of Section 9, Township 6 South, Range 5 East, the property of the Plaintiff.
