The condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above bound S.W. Jacobs, on the day of the date hereof hath obtained at the suit of Jacobs vs Dees, a summons and complaint for the recovery of personal property in specie against said defendant and asks an endorsement by the Clerk of this Court "That the Sheriff is required to take the property mentioned in said complaint into his possession," as required by law in such cases, which summons and complaint are returnable to the next term of the Circuit Court of said County, and which said endorsement is made upon the plaintiff entering into this bond.

Now, if the said plaintiff shall fail in this suit, and shall pay the defendant all such costs and damages as he may sustain by reason of the wrongful complaint in said case, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.
