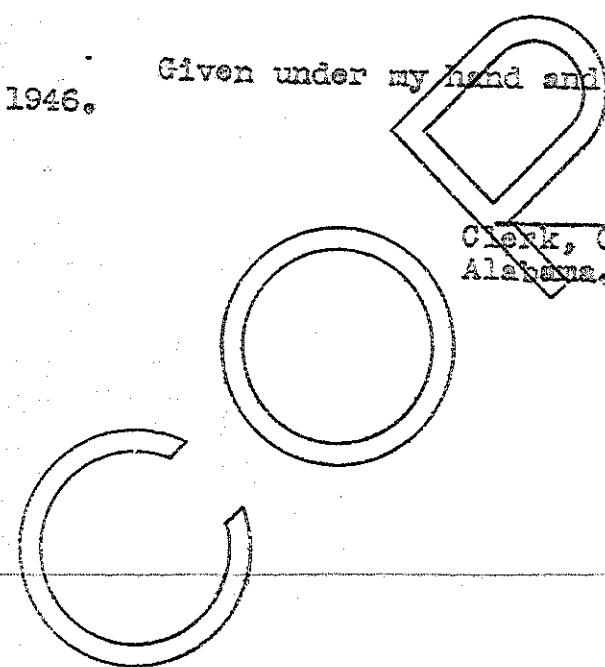

Charge: Drunk and disorderly conduct;
Resist arrest on Aug. 12, 1945

Plea of guilty of both charges.

Arresting Officers: Arnold, McLarin and Cox

Witnesses:

John Hall, Bernice Chaudron, Mrs. John Hall and Melvin Harbison

Evidence of officers that he was drunk and disorderly and knocked a man down in Burkel's dance hall and when placed under arrest, struck and choked officers and attempted to escape from police car etc.

Miss Bernice Chaudron testified in police court that he struck at her and when John Hall tried to interfere, the disorder started.

John Hall told officers at scene, in the presence of witnesses that he was knocked down by defendant when he attempted to protect Miss Chaudron.

As the conduct of the defendant precipitated a near riot in a crowded public dance hall the following penalties were levied:

Disorderly conduct-\$50.00 and cost of \$4.75 or 55 days hard labor.

Resist arrest and attempted escape from police car \$100.00 and cost of \$4.75 or 105 days hard labor.

Defendant appealed to Circuit court and bond of \$500.00 executed for his appearance.

_____ has on the day of the date of these presents claimed an APPEAL to the Circuit Court, next to be held in and for the County of Baldwin, in the State aforesaid, at the next Term thereof, from a judgment rendered on the 13th day of August 1945 by Howard Ruge Esq., Recorder of the Town of Fairhope and Ex-officio Justice of the Peace, in and for said Town, against said Lonnie Godwin requiring him to pay said Town of Fairhope One Hundred fifty-nine and 50/00 Dollars, as a fine, or One hundred days hard labor :

NOW if the said Lonnie Godwin shall appear at said term of said Circuit Court, and from term to term thereafter until discharged by due process of law, then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain of full force and effect.
