IN EQUITY.

1. The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) as damages for that heretofore on, to-wit: July 30, 1945, the Plaintiff's automobile was being operated along and upon a public highway, namely, U. S. Highway No. 31 at Spanish Fort, Alabama, about one-fourth of a mile Northeast of the intersection of the said highway with U. S. Highway No. 90, where she had a right to be, and while her said automobile was being operated and driven along the said highway, Defendants' truck which was then being operated and driven by the agent, servant, or employee of the Defendants, while acting within the line and scope of his authority, negligently ran said truck into or against Plaintiff's automobile and as the proximate

result of such negligence, Plaintiff was permanently injured on her hand, back and shoulder. The Plaintiff alleges that her said injury and damages were proximately caused by the said negligence of the Defendants' agent, servant or employee.

2. The Plaintiff claims of the Defendants One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) as damages for that heretofore on, to-wit: July 30, 1945, the Plaintiff's automobile was being operated along and upon a public highway, namely, U. S. Highway No. 31 at Spanish Fort, Alabama, about one-fourth of a mile Northeast of the intersection of the said highway with U. S. Highway No. 90, where she had a right to be, and while her said automobile was being operated and driven along the said highway, Defendants' truck, which was then and there being operated by the agent, servant or employee of the Defendants, while acting within the line and scope of his authority, negligently ran said truck into or against Plaintiff's automobile and as the proximate result of such negligence, Plaintiff's automobile was damaged and injured; the radiator frame was bent, windshield and door glasses were broken; radiator and grill were crushed beyond repair; one front fender, shield and bumper assembly were destroyed and motor mounts were bent; front spring bent beyond repair and otherwise injured and damaged all to the damage of the Plaintiff as aforesaid. The Plaintiff alleges that her said damages to her said automobile were proximately caused by the negligence of the Defendants' agent, servant or employee and as a proximate consequence thereof the Plaintiff's automobile was damaged and injured as aforesaid.
