The Plaintiff, an infant, suing by his next friend claims of the Defendant the sum of SEVENTY FIVE & 00/100 DOLLARS (\$75.00) as damages for this: That heretofore, and on to wit: February 2, 1946, the Plaintiff was riding in an automobile of his father, J. T. Faircloth, Sr., his next friend, when Defendant, his agent, servant or employee, while acting within the scope of his employment, so negligently drove and propelled a truck owned by said Defendant as to run into or against and to collide with the car driven by the said J. T. Faircloth, Sr., in which the said Plaintiff was riding at the invitation and request of his father, the said J. T. Faircloth, Sr., at an intersection on Bay Bridge Road at Old U. S. 90 Highway in the City of Mobile, Alabama, where he had a right to be. Plaintiff alleges that as a result of said collision he was bruised about the face and body and was otherwise injured. Plaintiff alleges that his injuries were proximately caused by the negligence of the Defendant, his agent, servant or employee, all to his damage as afore said.
