SECOND: Complainant further shows that at various times since their marriage and particularly within the last twelve months the defendant committed actual violence on her person, attended with danger to her life or health, by striking her on numerous occasions with his fist and with a stick and has further threatened her life, which threats from his cruelty she has reasonable apprehension may be carried into effect.

THIRD: Complainant specifically charges the defendant with violently striking her on or about the early part of the month of February, 1938, at which time he became so enraged that he secured a pistol, announcing his intention of killing her, but before he could use this she fled from the house and took refuge with a relative until his rage had quieted down. Since then she has left him and now lives separate and apart from him. Because of his abuse, repeated blows and threats she has serious grounds for apprehension that to continue to live with him her life would be in danger.

The above named witnesses appeared before me, JCSEPH POSE, as Commissioner, acting by agreement of parties without issue of commission at the time and place hereinafter stated and after being first duly sworn to testify only the truth, upon examination by Complainant, testified as is here set forth.

REBECCA BOSBY

I am the Complainant in this case and am now and have been for the rast thirteen years a resident of Baldwin County. I am over the age of twenty-one years and on March 31st, 1935 was married to Eugene Bosby in Foley Alabama where we lived together as husband and wife for about three months and then moved to Fairhope where we lived together up to February 1938 when I left him because of his bad treatment of me. He had been mean to me for about a year up to that time. He struck me a number of times without cause and about two weeks befor I left him the first time, drew a gun on me and threatened to kill me. I got away from him and shortly after, left him for fear of my life. He wouls strike me sometime s with his fist, at other times with a sti stick so that it was dangerous to live with him. When he drew the gun on me he showed plainly that he would hurt me or possibly kill me if I stayed with him longer so there was nothing else for me to do but to leave him before he carried out his threats. He told me he would kill me if I did not leave and after the way he had treated me I knew he wo would keep his word. A little after that he begged me to come back and give him another chance and I did but it did not do any good as he went back to abusing me and I left him again and this time have stayed away. If I go back he may kill me. I do not dare to live with him any longer. He is over twenty-one years of age and was born on Baldwin County. He lives in Fairhope.

LUCY DANIELS.

I am a sister of Rebecca Bosy and live next ddor to where she used to live with Eugene. I have never seen Eugene strike her but I know that he abused her and was cruel to her and that they did not get along together. She would often come over to my place and tell me and my mother of how she was treated and how he had struck and threateded to kill her. On two occasions when they had had more than ordinarilly serious trouble Eugene brought Rebeccae over to my house and told my mother to take her back, that he was through with her. Later, through on each occasion he came back again and got her. This last trouble they had she left him for good and has been living away from him ever since. She is very much afraid of him and feels that if she were to stay with him that he would carry out his treats and some day hurt her seriously if not do worse.
