COUNT ONE:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$260.00) due by Promissory Note made by him on October 8, 1946, and payable forty-five (45) days after date to the State Bank of Elberta, Alabama, which said note was endorsed by the Plaintiff and after the due date thereof upon the failure of the Defendant to pay said note, the Plaintiff paid the said State Bank of Elberta, Alabama, the sum of Two Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$260.00) and said note was duly transferred and assigned to the said Plaintiff, which sum of money, together with interest thereon at the rate of eight (8) percent per annum since October 15, 1947, is still due and unpaid.

The Plaintiff avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting, or securing, or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee whether the same be collected or secured by suit or otherwise, and the Plaintiff further claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.

The Plaintiff further avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant waived as to this debt or any renewal thereof, all rights to exemption under the constitution and laws of Alabama as to personal property and of this waiver the Plaintiff now claims the benefit.

COUNT TWO:

The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) due by Promissory Note made by him on August 3, 1946, and payable thirty (30) days after date to the State Bank of Elberta, Alabama, which said note was endorsed by the Plaintiff and after the due date thereof upon the failure of the Defendant to pay said note, the Plaintiff paid the said State Bank of Elberta, Alabama the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and said note was duly transferred and assigned to the said Plaintiff, which sum of money, together with interest thereon at the rate of eight (8) percent per annum since October 15, 1947, is still due and unpaid.

The Plaintiff avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant agreed to pay all costs of collecting, or securing, or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee whether the same be collected or secured by suit or otherwise, and the Plaintiff further claims of the Defendant the further and additional sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.

The Plaintiff further avers that in, by and as a part of said note the Defendant waived as to this debt or any renewal thereof, all rights to exemption under the constitution and laws of Alabama as to personal property and of this waiver the Plaintiff now
claims the benefit.
