

The plaintiff claims of the defendants Four Hundred Ninety-eight & 85/100 Dollars (\$498.85) with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent (8%) per annum, due by Promissory Note from May 24th, 1948, made by them on, to-wit, November 24, 1947, and due and payable on, to-wit, May, 24, 1948.

The plaintiff avers that in and by the terms of said note the defendant waived as to this debt all right of exemption under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, and of this waiver the plaintiff now claims the benefit.

The plaintiff further avers that in and by the terms of said note the defendants agreed to pay the cost of collecting or securing or attempting to collect or secure said note, including a reasonable attorney's fee, and the plaintiff further claims of defendant the further and additional sum of Seventy-five Bollars (\$75.00) as such reasonable attorney's fee.
