The Condition of the above obligation is such, That whereaas the above bound State Bank of Elberta, on the day of the date hereof hath obtained at the suit of State Bank of Elberta vs. Mrs. Oriel
C. Wood, a summons and complaint for the recovery of personal property in specie against said defendant and asks an endorsement by the
Clerk of this Court "That the Sheriff is required to take the property mentioned in said complaint into his possession," as required
by law in such cases, which summons and complaint are returnable to
the next term of the Circuit Court of Baldwin for said county, and
which said endorsement is made upon the plaintiff entering into this
bond.
