

COUNT II

The plaintiff claims of the defendant, to-wit, Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) Dollars as damages for that on, to-wit, the 13th day of March 1949, the defendant so negligently drove an automobile which he was operating on and along U. S. Highway 90, at a point about 150 feet West of the intersection of U. S. Highway 90 and U. S. Highway 31, in the County of Baldwin, State of Alabama, as to cause the same to run into, upon, over or against an automobile in which plaintiff was riding at said time and place, and as a proximate consequence and result of such negligence on the part of the defendant at said time and place, the plaintiff




