COUNT I

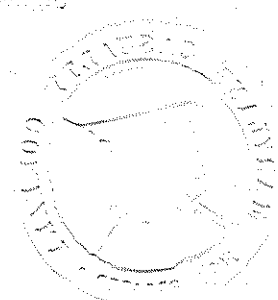
