The Plaintiff claims of the Defendant FIFTEEN HUNDRED (\$1500.00) DOLLARS, as damages, for that heretofore on to-wit, February 2, 1951, the Plaintiff was operating his pick up truck along the public highway leading from Bay Minette to Robertsedale, at or near the intersection of Alabama Highway 3 and U. S. Highway 90, approximately one-half mile North of Robertsedale in Baldwin County, Alabama; that at said time and place the Defendant so negligently operated an automobile which he was at said time and place driving, as to cause the said automobile to collide or come into contact with the truck of the Plaintiff, and as a proximate result of the negligence of the Defendant at said time and place the said automobile pick up of the Plaintiff was damaged as follows:
