The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound, S. M. Adams Inc., a corporation, on the day of the date hereof, has obtained at the suit of S. M. Adams, a summons and complaint for the recovery of the personal chattels in specie against Wiley Mitchell and ask endorsement of the Clerk of this County, that the "Sheriff is required to take the property mentioned in said complaint into his possession" as required by law in such case, which summons and complaint are returnable to the next term of Circuit Court of Baldwin County, Alabama, and which said endorsement is made upon the Plaintiff entering into this bond.
